

"OSCILLATIONS" 2022 OPEN CALL FOR ARTISTS UNDER 35

This open call is an invitation to artists under 35 of all nationalities to submit work related to photography, video art, installation, or performance. The work of the selected artists will be exhibited in the third edition of "OSCILLAZIONI", curated by Gianni Neri. It will take place from 30 July to 10 August 2022 in Pontremoli at Villa La Cartiera and the adjacent premises of the ice factory. The expression of artists from various backgrounds and languages will offer visitors a sentimental journey through art and nature.

Artists can participate both individually and within collectives by submitting one or more works. Participation is free and open to all artists under 35 years of age.

Artists who have been selected will be notified via email no later than **10 July 2022**. Artists participating in the event will be responsible for costs related to the production, transport and/or shipping of their work.

The winning artist will receive a prize of €400, in addition to exhibiting their work and promoting their portfolio.

Two additional finalists will be selected and invited to exhibit their work in Oscillazioni OFF. All costs must be covered by the artists.

How to participate:

The call is open to all Italian and international visual artists. Candidates must be able to present a project that has already been completed or is in progress for the exhibition.

Application Requirements:

1. Detailed description of the work that includes the title, a caption with year, technique, materials, and measurements in a single PDF

2. Motivation Letter
3. Portfolio
4. Biography

Each of the files must be signed with the candidate's name and surname.
